We again offer positions in two teams to continue work that have been commenced this year. The Teams will work in the same geographic area of Nepal whilst enabling communities to receive a much needed facility

Expedition Price:	\$3,850
Inclusions:	Most meals, accommodation, internal transport, trekking permits, local staff costs - guide and porters (employment), project donation, leadership & logistical support.
Exclusions:	Flight arrangements (incl taxes), Visa, personal gear and clothing, immunisations, personal travel insurance, lunches and 4 dinners when in Kathmandu/Bhaktapur, spending money.
Group size:	Maximum 10 people (1 group per date period)

Aussie Action Abroad Ltd (AAA) uses basic accommodation at all times. Depending on location and practicality, this may include camping (tents supplied), dormitories, local hostel accommodation and basic hotels.

Prior to departure, AAA supplies participants with all the information they need regarding gear, inoculations, culture & climate, etc. Detailed material will be sent on enquiry which includes an outlined program of planned activity.

Project funds: 10% of each participant fee is allocated to the purchase of materials for projects, but you may choose to seek additional funds from your community to add to the finances available. All funds raised will be given to the organisations when the group is in Nepal.

- Working alongside local tradesmen and NGOs to facilitate Design & construction of a community facility for a village

- Nepali Architecture students joining our trip for the construction phase
- Short Trek within the Annapurna Conservation Area
- Historic Architecture tours around World heritage sites of Kathmandu & Bhaktapur
